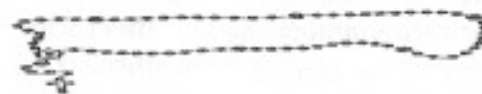

Your PVG Scheme ID/ Membership number can be found on the left hand side of the PVG Scheme record and is 16 digits long. The number will begin 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, etc. on the year the applicant first joined the PVG scheme

When a person is admitted to hospital, or a relative/friend, should give to ward-staff to ensure they can see a Catholic Chaplain. This can also be achieved through a verbal-request to staff. This is necessary due to the way confidentiality rules are applied in most hospitals.

Gift Aid:

If you are still considering being a Member of the Gift Aid Scheme please ask Canon Conroy about it ~ Canon Conroy shall give you a GAD Form and Booklets for 2018/19.

Alternatively, a Mandate is available if you wish to pay by Direct Debit.

Either way, Parishioners should fill in a GAD Form as the Archdiocese of Glasgow require all those taking part in Gift Aid: whether it be through the Weekly Scheme or via the new Restoration Fund (Yellow Booklets) to complete a Gift Aid Declaration Form.

If you are an existing Member of the above and have not filled out a GAD Form please let Canon Conroy know and he shall supply the Form, as we cannot claim your donations without the Form being completed.
