SAFEGUARDING STATEMENT

Around the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels, which this year falls on the 2nd October the Archdiocese focuses our attention on Safeguarding by publishing a Safeguarding Statement which is available on our noticeboard.

Safeguarding concerns everyone of us, clergy faith communities and lay people. In our parish we have two Safeguarding Officers whose contact details are recorded on a poster on the notice boards and in the chapel hall. These Safeguarding Officers are responsible for ensuring that those who volunteer to work in our parish are recruited in line with safe recruitment practices and that volunteers only start their ministry once a series of suitability checks have been completed, including a Protection of Vulnerable Groups, (PVG) check where appropriate.

These volunteers undertake training which is a mandatory part of our procedures as is being vigilant, looking out for each other, and passing on any concerns. We currently have 35 volunteers who work together to ensure that our parish family, places and activities are safe.
