Bell Tower

Work is required to maintain the bell tower. The first stages is to renew the grills inside the Louvres to prevent access by birds and the corrosion they and the weather cause to the metal framework which holds the bells. There will also be added a new galebreaker screen to prevent the rain from further corroding the frame. The second stage will be to clean the frame and add a preservative to the metal before repainting. The work on the first stage will commence on 1st November and should take 3 days. The cost of Stage One is £8,997.60.
