Taize

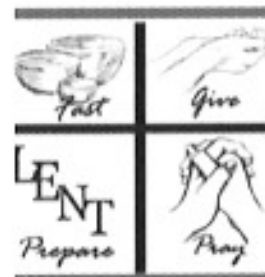

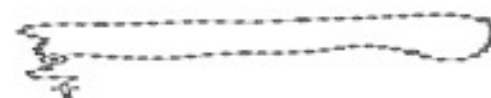

Gift Aid

The only stipulation is that you fill out a Declaration form saying you are paying tax and wish the parish to reclaim some of the tax you are paying. If you currently assist through the new Restoration Fund and are using the yellow envelopes please note that you need to fill out a declaration form unless you have already done so. Without this the Parish cannot claim the tax refund from the government. Please ask the Parish Gift Aid coordinator if you are unclear.
