- 2 Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you. (*Spend about a minute on each of the following points*)
- 3 Read Matthew 5:17-37
- 4 Imagine yourself sitting among the crowd listening to the words of Jesus. Already you have heard a lot of things—new things—different things.
- 5 How do people react to what they are hearing?
- 6 What do you think about what you are hearing?
- 7 What do you feel about what you have heard?
- 8 What things do you like? What things do you find difficult to hear?
- 9 Now talk to God about it.
- 10 Spend some time in silence in God's company.
