### Parish PVG Scheme

It has become necessary to record PVG Number and date of issue for all parishioners registered under the scheme. Would you please record your name, PVG No and Date of issue and hand into the Sacristy. Your PVG Scheme ID/Membership number can be found on the left hand side of the PVG Scheme record and is 16 digits long. The number will begin 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, etc. on the year the applicant first joined the PVG scheme.

When a person is admitted to hospital, or a relative/friend, should give to ward-staff to ensure they can see a Catholic Chaplain. This can also be achieved through a verbal request to staff. This is necessary due to the way confidentiality rules are applied in most hospitals.
