

St Pius of Pietrelcina (1887—1968)

He was born in the small village of Pietrelcina in southern Italy, and joined the Capuchin friars at the age of 16. He became a priest seven years later, and spent fifty years at the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo, where he was very much sought after as a spiritual advisor, confessor, and intercessor. Many miracles were popularly ascribed to him during his lifetime. He died a few days after the fiftieth anniversary of his receiving the stigmata, and over 100,000 people attended his funeral.

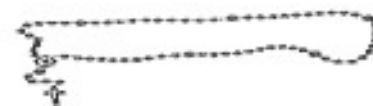

BUILDING UPDATE

Church : -

The Work on the Bell Tower and Bell Frame is now complete. The final cost of the work was £31,716. We hope to be able to reclaim the VAT paid on this work.

House : -

The work on the roof of the house is progressing and we hope it will be finished before the end of September. At present the cost has been reduced to £110,000.

Hall: -

We are hopeful of being able to appoint a contractor next week. The work would then begin in a fortnight's time and we expect the work to take approximately 12 weeks barring unforeseen complications. The cost of the work would be no more than £170,000 unless further rot was discovered after work was begun.
