SCALAN PILGRIMAGE: It is hoped to run a bus from the Dumbarton/Vale area to the annual Mass at Scalan on Sunday 2nd July, 4pm. Scalan is a few miles from Tomintoul, the eastern Grampians – so, a good four-hour drive. It was the site of Scotland's seminary-school for the education of young men throughout the 18th century – including the period of the Jacobite Rising 1745-46 and its aftermath. The main building, which included a small chapel, is still standing, and Mass is celebrated there each year. We need to have an idea of numbers before the end of May.
