FIND – Weekly event for 16-25 Year Olds

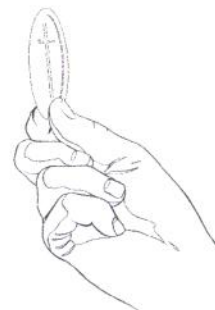

November Lists

November is the month in which we traditionally remember the souls of the dead. During the month of November, Holy Mass will be offered each day for the repose of the souls you wish to be prayed for. November Lists and envelopes are available at the back of the Church on which you can write the names of those for whom you wish to have Mass offered. The envelopes will be opened and the lists removed and placed on the Altar during November.

GAD Forms are available for you—please ask Father Conroy for a Form and if you would like to claim Gift Aid we shall be able to do this for you. Thank you.
