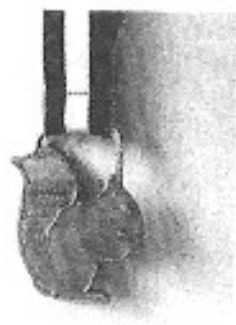
## 1ST SATURDAY:
